These should be paid before your child(ren) can take part in any training or matches and include all junior match fees as well as all coaching and training sessions, both indoor and outside. A t-shirt for junior training is also included which should be worn to all sessions on Friday evenings.

Training Information

Children are generally coached in the following school year groups where the child's school year is that as at September 2021.

Pre-season training – Robert Smyth Academy

Dates - Friday evenings – 25th March to 8th April inclusive.

Boys and Girls in school years 5 and 6 (U11's) from 6pm to 8pm.

Boys and Girls in school years 7 and 8 (U13's) from 6pm to 8pm.

Boys and Girls in school years 9 and 10 (U15's) from 6pm to 8pm.

Kwik Cricket – 8th April only (School Years 2, 3 and 4) 6pm to 7pm for this week only.

Outdoor Training – Bowden CC (Recreation Ground at Great Bowden)

Dates – Friday evenings from Friday 22nd April to 2nd September inclusive.

Boys and Girls – Year 2 to Year 8 from 6.30pm to 8pm.

Boys and Girls – Year 9 and 10 from 5.30pm to 6.30pm in the nets followed by fielding practice.

During these sessions an assessment will be made in conjunction with the player, coaches and the parent/guardian as to whether they are also invited to senior training. Players who in previous years have attended Senior Training, please carry on as before.

It is also intended that girls who are likely to play in the senior women's teams will also be invited to their (senior) net training.

The training sessions will cover fitness drills, batting, bowling, fielding, wicket keeping and team working.

Kwik cricket will be with a soft ball and hard ball will generally be used for year 5 and upwards.

Match Information

Kwik Cricket (year 4 and below) – friendly matches as arranged on Friday evenings (It is anticipated more will be arranged this season especially against other Corby & Kettering District clubs).

Under 11's (Boy's year 6 (Girls year 7) and below) – Sunday mornings starting at 10am (end April onwards)

Under 13's (Boy's year 8 (Girls year 10) and below) – Monday evenings starting at 6pm (end April onwards)

Under 15's (Boy's year 10 (Girls year 12) and below) – Tuesday evenings starting at 6pm (end April onwards)

(Some children are also likely to be invited to play in older age groups as and when required)
