



Notes on Proposed New Non-Turf Static Practice Nets

- performance and longevity
- playability, with a premium low-maintenance turfed playing surface • To be fully enclosed, increasing safety both inside and outside the ground
- This allows the new footprint to be rotated parallel to the boundary fence, reducing the wasted space
- This allows the new rootprint to be rotated parallel to the boundary relied, reducing the wasted space between the two and as a consequence maximising the grass playing area to the main square
 The increased length of the nets, a consequence of being fully enclosed, means the facility is no longer reliant on a grass approach, which is at the mercy of the weather, particularly during the winter
